



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
PRINCESS OF NARADHIWAS UNIVERSITY, NARATHIWAT THAILAND
AND
STATE COLLEGE FOR ISLAMIC STUDIES (STAIN) OF MANADO, INDONESIA**

In order to promote the mutual interests between the Parties, Princess of Naradhiwas University, Narathiwat, Thailand, and State College for Islamic Studies (STAIN) of Manado, Indonesia agree to exercise their best efforts to develop the following forms of cooperation:

- a) Joint research activities and academic programs;
- b) Exchange of information, not limited to exchange of library materials but includes research publications;
- c) Exchange of faculty members for the development of both faculties;
- d) Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students for study and research;
- e) Exchange of community services; including exchange of social-cultural activities; and
- f) Invitation of authorized officials to visit and to develop cooperative mechanisms between the parties.

Both parties shall appoint a coordinator from each party for the development and management of joint activities.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

Details for the implementation of specific projects will be mutually developed.

In the event where both parties formalize the abovementioned academic and research collaboration, the parties have agreed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) of which the MoU has a binding effect on both parties.

The undersigned being duly authorized thereto, have signed this Memorandum of Understanding, on this 15 day of November 2013.
